

*Governor General's Speech*

A postal convention has recently been signed whereby the rate of postage between Canada and France has been reduced.

The approval of parliament has been given to the general treaty for the renunciation of war; to the protocol for the prohibition of the use in war of asphyxiating, poisonous or other gases, and of bacteriological methods of warfare, and to the convention and protocol between Canada and the United States regarding the Niagara falls and the Niagara river.
