## PUBLICATIONS.

Among the numerous publications issued by the Museum the following are suitable for educational use:—

POSTCARDS. Coloured postcards (125 subjects) and monochrome cards (674 subjects) are available, price 2d. and 1d. each respectively. Sets illustrating various subjects, e.g. Bayeux Tapestry, English Heraldry, Æsop's Fables, Labours of the Months, etc., may also be obtained.

PICTURE BOOKS. Nearly fifty of these popular booklets have now been issued. Each one contains twenty illustrations and a short introduction, price 6d. each. Among other titles suitable for use in schools are: Roman Alphabets, Children in Sculpture, Dolls and Dolls' Houses, Leatherwork, English Chairs, English Embroideries (4 parts), etc.

SHEETS OF LETTERING, with letters designed by Eric Gill, price 6d. each. Four of these are available in a size suitable for use in the class room (15 by  $22\frac{1}{2}$  in.): 1. Incised alphabet of Roman capitals in red, on Hoptonwood stone. 2. Incised alphabet in lower case italic letters, and numerals, on Hoptonwood stone. 3. Incised text in red, black, and blue on Hoptonwood stone. 4. Painted text in red and black on grey board.
