

members, exclusive of any member of the Committee, be present.

32. Any ordinary or privileged member who shall remove his residence from Quebec (all his subscriptions then due being paid) may give notice to the Secretary-Treasurer of such removal and of his intention not to make use of the Club thenceforward and such member shall pay a yearly subscription of four dollars (\$4.00) if an ordinary member and two dollars (\$2.00) if a privileged member, so long as he continues to reside out of Quebec and he shall retain the privileges and benefits of such membership in all matters. Such member shall, at any time, have the right of again using the Club by notifying his intention so to do and paying the subscription for the current year.

But if any member, so removing his residence from Quebec and taking advantage of this rule should again return to Quebec, he shall, within one month from
