

such applicant conspicuously in the rooms, the entrance fee having been deposited, and such applicant shall not be balloted for unless at the next regular meeting of the Society. Three black balls shall reject a candidate.

ARTICLE III.

Fraudulent Membership. Any person who shall become a member fraudulently, by making a false entry of the time of his arrival within the limits of British Columbia, shall be expelled from the Society, and shall forfeit any amount he may have paid.

ARTICLE IV.

Life Members. On payment of Fifty (\$50) Dollars by any member, he shall be released from all further payments of dues, and shall be considered a Life Member of the Society.

ARTICLE V.

Members' dues and neglect to pay. Every member of this Society over the age of twenty-one years, shall pay into the Treasury semi-annually, \$2.50, in advance. Any member who shall neglect to pay such dues for Twelve (12) months, may be stricken from the roll of membership; but any person so stricken from the roll, upon the payment of all arrearages, may by that act be re-admitted by a vote of the Directors.
