- 32. And lo! the Question was carried in the Affirmitive, without any Debate.
- 33. And it was ordered by the said Coun—1, that the said Freedom should be presented forthwith in Boxes of pure Gold, to a great Value.
- Right, and gloried in their Liberty.
- 35. But, there was great Murmers among the other Party, whose Malice were too much to be kept within Bounds.
- 36. And they swell'd, even like a Toad, tall their Venom burst from them, and sprinkled upon the R—l Garments, which were before unfullied.
- 37. And therefore there were great Fermentations among them; and Abasuerus was not well pleased at the Men of the City.
