more at their Ease, than the English off the Newsoundland Coast, they can at Pleasure disturb our Fishery, as we might have done theirs, and have destroy'd it entirely, by the entire Possession of the Land also; for Cape Breton-Isle commands the Entrance into St. Laurence's Bay, and is aptly situated for cutting offall Communication, not only hetween Quebec and all the Fishing Harbours in Laurence, but between Canada and Europe. 'Tis easy to be explained if it was proper; but Cape Breton-Isle is lost to us.
