Catch Weights are, each party to appoint a person to ride without weighing.

Feather Weights.—A horse carries Feather Weight, when the terms of the race allow the owner to place what rider he pleases on his back; he consequently procures the lightest eligible jockey possible, who weighs neither before nor after the race.

A Maiden Horse or Mare is one that has never won.

An Untried Stallion or Mare is one whose produce has never run in public.

A Post Match is to insert the age of the horses in the article, and to run any horse of that age, without declaring what horse, until he comes to the post to start.
