A YANKEE IN CANADA.

And still older, in Thomas Morton's "New English Canaan," published in 1632, it is said, on page 97, "From this Lake [Erocoise] Northwards in derived the famous River of Canada, so named, of Monsier de Cane, a Fre A Lord. who first planted a Colony of French in America."
