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SHIP'S SEIZURE WAS
FOR MAIL OBTAINED

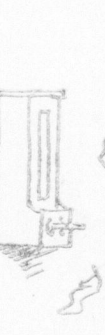
Germans Captured Dutch Channel Boat to Search Letters.

London, Jan. 22.—An Amsterdam dispatch to the Times says that it is believed there is the chief reason for the seizure by German warships of the Dutch mail steamer Prins Hendrik was to search its mails. There were 1,500 bags of mail matter on board, and these were examined at Ostend. It is reported that mail destined for German prisoners was returned, as was also American packages. The remainder is supposed to have been taken to Berlin.

Among the letters on board were held as prisoners was an Antwerp merchant, who is above military age. It is believed that his detention is connected with his business or financial position.

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
