

TRACES EVOLUTION OF CHRISTIANITY

Rev. S. G. Bland Forecasts New Era of Tolerance and Brotherhood.

Rev. Dr. Salem G. Bland's new book, "The New Christianity," just published, is the epitome in historical idealism of that new sense of Christian democracy which is fast superseding the old order of orthodoxy, exemplifying as it does the running of old waters in an entirely new channel, in other words, the substitution of democratic toleration for the ancient and limited ideal of hell fire and brimstone and all that they imply.

This new history, past, present and future of the Christian movement in civilization, deftly traces the movement thru the days of autocratic government by kings, this is superseded later by the even more autocratic church, the throne and papacy and relates on thru the still later stages of government by parliamentary procedure, when Protestantism was looming on the horizon as the deliverer of the world from an almost intolerable era of religious insanity.

Much Co-operate or Fall.

The book then continues its treatment of the Christian evolution, until finally it reaches the stages of essentially democratic ideal, in which the two forces of state and church of world, power and religion, must work in harmonious co-operation or fall together into ignominious oblivion. Perhaps this is most apparent, it points out that the newly-awakened world of what may be termed modern Christianity, the movement which has many ramifications has many interests, and is undoubtedly the most tolerant of all the phases thru which the movement has passed.
