ANOTHER VICTIM OF PRIZE RING

Harry Tenney Dead from "Dope" and Brutal Punishment

Victim Succumbed from Knockout at Hands of Frank Neil of Frisco for Bantam Championship—Doctors Find Strychnine and Other Drugs Had Been Given Him—Many Arrests Made, But Only Small Bail is Asked.

San Francisco, March 1.—Harry Tenney, who was knocked out last night by Frank Neil, the bantam champion pugilist, died today. After making an autopsy Surgeon Cusack announced that Tenney's death was due to cerebral hemorrhage, probably caused by a blow. It was discovered that strychnine and possibly other drugs were given Tenney during the fight.

Physicians who remained at the bedside realized his desperate condition and gave warning that death might be expected if the fighter could not be resuscitated within a short time.

Some uneasiness was felt last night by persons connected with the contest, when the condition of Tenney after the knockout was noted. He went down before Neil's hard left hand blow during the fourteenth round, falling near the center of the ring. The timekeeper counted him out but in the noise of the shouting before he had time to complete the count and when Tenney staggered to his feet all eyes were fixed on him.

A blow of diversion greeted the fighter, but it was soon ended, for Neil went at his opponent like a madman and hammered him in his weakened condition against the ropes. Hopeless and without strength to strike a blow in return, Tenney dropped against the ropes. His head sank on his chest and his arms dropped to his sides. In this position Tenney was literally beaten to the floor by Neil and was counted out by the referee. He was carried to his dressing room. When he was revived an hour later he complained of terrible blows with which Neil had reached his stomach. Later the defeated man was removed to the bath house, where he grew worse until death ended his suffering.

Tenney Poisoned, Too.

Mark Shaughnessy attended Tenney at the bath. The beaten pugilist complained of terrible pains in his stomach and head. At 5 o'clock this morning he fell asleep and the physician left, saying that all danger was over. At 7:30 o'clock Shaughnessy was awakened by a cry from Tenney. The pugilist's body was doubled up in agony and a hurly call was sent in for the central emergency ambulance. Before it arrived Tenney was dead.

After he was taken to the hall, Dr. McGinnis was summoned. Tenney's heart action was very weak and the pulse dropped to forty. Strong stimulants were administered and this morning Dr. McGinnis pronounced him out of danger.

"How do you feel, Harry?" asked Shaughnessy.

"I'm awful sick. My stomach and head hurt awfully," answered Tenney.

Shortly afterward he dropped asleep. No physician was in attendance from that time until he died.

The news of Tenney's death spread quickly over the city. Orders were at once given at police headquarters to arrest all concerned.

Neil soon surrendered himself, as also did James Crofford, Eddie Graney, Willis Britt, Morris Levy and Mark Shaughnessy. All were charged with manslaughter. They promptly made arrangements for release on bail, and each was released from custody on depositing \$500 cash.

It is said that two days ago Tenney had an epileptic fit.

MORE DETAILS OF THE NANCHANG MASSACRE

Shanghai, March 1.—The following account of the recent attack on foreign missionaries at Nanchang has been received: Fifteen Methodist, twelve English Protestant and fourteen French Catholic missionaries were in the city last Thursday night when the French Catholics had quarrel with an official over a suit for the possession of property. Great excitement prevailed on Friday. A mass meeting was held on Saturday and was followed on Sunday by a riot during which the property of the Catholics was burned. Captain Fletcher, commanding the American ships, had the location of every American missionary in the Yangtze valley.

After consultation on Monday, Captain Fletcher ordered the gunboat El Cano from Nanchang to meet the fugitives at Kinkiang or Poyang lake. They were met at Kinkiang.

The cause of the riot was local. Serious blame attaches to the French Catholics, Chinese, friendly to the missionaries, object to priests exercising civil functions.

There is much discussion throughout China, but there is no indication of a general uprising against foreigners.

AGAINST SUPPLY DEPARTMENT

Three Directors Tell Treasury Board It is Not Needed

SUPT. GLASGOW IS IN FAVOR

Matter of Permanent Auditor Goes to Committee—Board of Trade Has Appointment of Grain Inspector—Firemen's Petition Goes to Safety Board.

At a meeting of the treasury board yesterday afternoon the directors of the various departments were heard with reference to establishing a purchasing department. Three were not in favor of the system. A return was asked for as to the amount expended annually, exclusive of tenders. The recorder gave an opinion that the board had no authority to act. A lengthy discussion on the question of appointing one permanent auditor to act for the city, county and school trustees took place. Ald. Bullock occupied the chair and Ald. MacGee, Vanwart, McArthur, Holder, MacRae, Frink, Baxter, Pickett and Tibbo were present with Dr. Director Cushing, Walsh, Murdoch, Superintendent Glasgow, the chamberlain and common clerk.

Against Purchasing Department.

On the question of establishing a purchasing department for the city's supplies, Director Cushing said the work of providing for his department did not occupy more than half an hour of his time every day. Frequently the member of the department making the requisition was authorized to make the purchase.
