IN PRODUCTION OF
PNEUMATIC TIRES
New York, July 31—Fifty per cent cut in production of pneumatic tires in July, August and September as compared with the same months last year, was asked of the rubber industry in a letter from George N. Peck, commissioner of finished products of the war industries board, which was read before 400 members of the trade at a meeting here today. This restriction would be exclusive of government business.
