

Observance on Tomorrow And Monday - Some of the Ceremonies and Features

As stated in yesterday's Times, Rabbi Nachman Heller will conduct the services in connection with the Jewish New Year and other feasts at the Hazan Avenue synagogue in this city.

The feast of Rosh Hashanah or New Year's Day, which inaugurates the most solemn season of the Jewish religious year, will begin this year on tomorrow (Sunday) evening, and last till sundown on Monday, the twenty-first. Among orthodox Jews who celebrate two days, the following day, Tuesday, is also observed. This day opens the Jewish calendar year 5675.

The observance of this day as a holy season is commanded in two passages of the Five Books of Moses, namely Leviticus XXIII, 24 and 25, and Numbers XXIX, 1. In neither passage is there any specific command as to how the day is to be observed beyond the injunctions to blow the trumpet, to hold a holy convocation and to engage in no servile occupation.

MOUNT ALLISON RHODES SCHOLAR LEAVES FOR OXFORD

Moncton Farewell to Wm. H. Irving - English Letter Tells of Russian Troops

Moncton, N. B., Sept. 10. - William H. Irving, B.A., a Rhodes scholar, left on Friday afternoon for Oxford University. After graduating from the Aberdeen High School here he attended Mount Allison, where he made an excellent showing and graduated two years ago. Mr. Irving was chosen by the Mount Allison faculty as Rhodes scholar. Since then he has been engaged as a teacher on the Aberdeen High School staff. On Thursday night the Canadian Club, of which he has been secretary, tendered him a complimentary luncheon, and E. A. Reilly, K.C., read an address to Mr. Irving. Among the speakers was Rev. Dr. Campbell, president of the Ladies' College, Mount Allison.

Dr. Campbell, who responded to the toast, "The British Empire," said that in his opinion the great battle of the present European war had not yet been fought. He had no fear of the future. The allies would triumph, and Canada would benefit commercially through loss of German foreign trade.
