BAVARIANS ARE ANGRY.

Report of Cases of Friction With the Prussians.

London, Nov. 28.—More stories of dissatisfaction of the Bavarian troops are reaching here. A Paris dispatch to the Standard supplements the accounts of the fraternizing of French and Bavarian outposts in the Vosges region.

"There will be an attack tonight, but you can rely upon us firing into the air. We shall be replaced by Prussians in a day or two, and I will let you know when this occurs."

"This," says the Standard's correspondent, "is what a Bavarian officer said to a French lieutenant, who walked boldly into the enemy's trenches. Of course, the statement represents an extreme case, but there is no doubt that serious friction exists between the Bavarians and the Prussians, who are fighting together. Several incidents reported go far to prove this.

"Bavarians and Prussians have undoubtedly come to blows regarding the Queen of the Belgians, who is a Bavarian princess. Further, it is now reported that a serious disagreement has arisen between the imperial chancellor and the prime minister of Bavaria. What is undeniable is that the Bavarian troops take every possible opportunity to surrender.

"KEEP AWAY FROM CHICAGO"

Warning to Young Girls Sent Out by Travelers' Aid Department of Chicago Y. W. C. A.

Chicago, Nov. 28.—"Keep young girls away from Chicago." This is the substance of a warning letter planned to be sent over the country by the Travelers' Aid Department of the Chicago Young Women's Christian Association. Difficulty of obtaining employment has augmented the dangers to which young women, strangers in the city, are exposed.

"There never was a time in the history of Chicago," said Mrs. Wilhelmina Barr, secretary of the Travelers' Aid, when it was so difficult to obtain employment for stranger girls. This condition necessarily increases the dangers to which they are exposed."

Six classes of girls are named in the letters of warning which the organization plans to send to newspapers in the principal cities of the country. They are: "Girls afflicted with the wanderlust, employed girls who seek better wages, immigrants, girls coming to visit relatives or friends whose places of abode they do not know, show girls and runways."
