1. Rules of Procedure 22 and 23 are complied with. #
 2. The order convening the Court is read in the presence of the accused.
 3. The accused is asked the following question:
"Do you object to be tried by the President or any Members of the Court whose names you have heard read over?"

Answer: "No."
 4. The President, Members, Officers under instruction and Shorthand Writer are duly sworn.
 5. (a) The accused answers to his name and number, and is duly arraigned on both charges, shown on Charge Sheet marked B-1.

(b) The accused pleads "not guilty" to both charges.
 6. The accused is asked the question at the foot of page 2 of A.F.A.3., and his answer is recorded beneath the question.
 7. The Prosecutor makes a request for adjournment to permit the attendance of witnesses at present on leave.
 8. The Court allows this request, the Court being adjourned to 1000 hours the Seventh day of January, 1941., at the same place.
