

BRITISH PARLIAMENT PROROGUES UNTIL FEB. 15

SHALL FIGHT UNTIL FUTURE OF CIVILIZATION ASSURED, KING GEORGE DECLARES

His Majesty's Speech at Prorogation of Parliament Briefest on Record for Such an Occasion—Relies with Confidence on the Loyal and United Efforts of His Subjects.

London, Jan. 27.—Parliament was prorogued today until Feb. 15. In the prerogative King George said: "We shall not lay down our arms until we have vindicated the cause which carries with it the future of civilization."

San Juan, P. R., Jan. 26.—The burning of the four-masted American schooner Forest City in San Juan harbor a few nights ago marked the close of the career of a vessel long known along the Atlantic coast as a "hoodoo ship."

FOR TRIAL IN APRIL. William S. Bannister offers no defense on serious charge.

Hopewell Cape, Jan. 27.—William S. Bannister of Forest Glen, Parish of Algiers, was held for trial at the April term of the Circuit Court by Police Magistrate E. B. Peck, on a statutory charge. The case, which is one of the most revolting ever before the courts of the province, involves four of his daughters.

The entire cargo was lost with the ship. It was valued at \$125,000, and the Forest City cost \$40,000 when she was built at Millbridge, Me., in 1904. She was owned by Frankel & Co. Her captain, H. B. Allen, was making his first trip as her master. It is said that the Forest City never made a voyage without mishap. On her last trip she was blown far out of her course, and when she put into San Juan she was leaking badly, with several spars gone. Three of her crew had contracted beriberi during her seventy-one days' run from Africa.
