The mere appointment of these eighteen extras to permanencies affects other clerks in the Department, who have struggled on from \$300 at an increase of \$50 per annum for four years, and after close application to their duties they find themselves, placed on a par, with the "Macs" from Glengarry and its neighborhood, whose temporary services have been rewarded during their engagement with an addition of two dollars per diem.
