

COUSIN BLADE-A-GRASS, by Lloyd Garber is an ambitious undertaking (265 pages)
for a method book on avant-garde guitar technique, and more important, it is written by
one of its more visible exponents. But despite
its great length, it isn't as formidable as one
might fear. Garber gives straightforward information concerning intervallic relationships,
tonal schemes, inversions, and clusters (as
well as other topics), and keeps the language
at an understandable level. In many cases, he
uses nonmusical examples to relate such
musical concepts as tone quality, tendencies uses nonmusical examples to relate such musical concepts as tone quality, tendencies of harmonic motion, etc. These are backed up with musical examples, as well as exercises. Sections encompassing the use of harmonics and prepared strings are also present, as are sketches for several of the author's compositions. Besides offering technical guidance, this softbound is also an enjoyable way of wading into the turbulent subject of the avant-garde. 
