

**An Act for the better observance of the Sabbath by preventing all labor on the Carillon and Grenville Canal on Sundays.**

**W**HEREAS it is expedient and proper that to secure the better observance of the Sabbath, all those persons engaged in the navigation of the Carillon and Grenville Canal, whether mariners, lock-tenders, or teamsters, should be relieved from the obligation to labor on Sundays :  
 5 Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

Preamble.

I. From and after the passing of this Act, it shall not be lawful for any craft, boat, barge, or steamer, to navigate the waters of the Carillon and Grenville Canal on the Sabbath ; and it shall not be lawful for any lock-keeper, or person in charge of any lock on the said Canal, to permit any such craft, boat, barge, or steamboat to pass through the lock  
 10 or locks of the said Canal on the Sabbath day.

No work to be done on Sunday on the said Canal.
