SIXTH YEAR THE ELECTIONS IN QUEBEC

ONLY SEVEN RETURNS BY ACCLAMATION.
Indicates that the Present Government will be handily re-elected.

MONTEAL, Oct. 7.—Nominations for the House of Assembly took place all over the province today except in Quebec, where R. J. Flynn, Solicitor-General, was the only return by acclamation. The rest of the returns were made by ballot.

Present appearances indicate that this will be about the average in the new House, as little something was done to-day, except that Thursday, polling day, the Government cannot fail to be sustained by a large majority.

The Riel question is not an issue except in English-speaking constituencies where it crops up and again.
