Dear Sir:-

I have your letter of the 15th, and note that my letter to the Honourable Minister of the Interior has been mis-understood. In my letter referred to, I requested the Minister of the Interior to advise me as to whether a portion of the Indian Reserve adjacent to Semans, Sask. was to be made available for the purposes of settlement, under the Soldiers' Settlement Act.

As your letter of the 15th does not reply to my question, I would request you to kindly advise me if this land is, or is not to be made available for en stewar Soldiers! Settlement.
