In reply to your letter of the 5th ultime I beg to inform you that the Department will not take any action to transfer James Luke and family from No. 91 Moose Factory Band to the Matagama Band until the Band passes a resolution, in the presence of Indian Agent Godfrey, agreeing to the transfer.

You should, therefore, inform Luke that it will be necessary for him to make application for the transfer through Indian Agent Godfrey who will then take up the matter with the Chief and Council of the Band.
