Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 4th ultimo, and previous correspondence, I beg to inform you that you may expend \$50.00 for repairs to the roads on the Arton Reserve. Indian labour should be employed. You should have a close oversight of the work. A cheque for \$50.00 to cover the cost of labour, etc. is being forwarded to you. You should account for the expenditure of the same on labour return forms, a supply of which was sent you recently with instruction for rendering the same.

With reference to the last paragraph of Department's letter of the 28th June, I have to inform you that it is not the intention of the Department to make any repairs to the roads on the Heatherton Reserve this year.
