



Ottawa, July 30th., 1918.

Sirs:-

With reference to your letter of the 23rd instant, and previous correspondence, I beg to say that your account for June supplies, sent to the Department under cover of letter above quote shows different articles as having been supplied than those enumerated in the two accounts previously sent to the Department. This makes it appear that you keep no record of supplies given out and quite reasonably the doubt arises if the Indians for whom payment is to be made for supplies are actually getting all that is being paid for. Payment of accounts will be given consideration when full explanations are given as to your method of giving out supplies to needy Indians.
