Rev. Sir,-



Mr. Inspector Bunt has forwarded to the Department a copy of your letter addressed to him, dated the 1st inst. in which you state that you are sending teachers for the summer months for these three schools and ask that school supplies and biscuits be sent for them.

The Department is ordering from the Government Stationery Office a supply of school material for each of these schools and Mr. Bunt has been instructed to send some biscuits for each school.

I have to ask you to be good enough to furnish the Department as soon as possible with full information in regard to the teachers you are sending to take charge of these three schools.
