Herewith "Report on Conduct" of the marginally-noted soldier, duly completed.

2. It is advised that Medical Board proceedings were brought forward, which show the marginally noted soldier has varicose veins on both lower legs and refuses remedial treatment. The psychiatric report shows a Fulhams Profile of M-1, S-1.

3. The sentence of the marginally-noted soldier was to be reviewed after three months, depending on the conduct of the soldier. In view of the fact that this soldier has failed to earn the eight days remission of sentence up to the 8th February, 1944, recommendation for review has not been put forward.
