## After Finding.

Lieut S. G. Parent, Royal 22e Regiment, sworn

I produce a certified true copy of M.F.M. 6. (A.F.B 122) relating to the accused. (The said copy is marked Appendia "B", signed by the President and attached to the proceedings)

## Question to the accused.

- Q 1. De you wish to address the Court, or to call evidence as to character ?.
- A. No, Sir.

The Defending Officer makes the following plea in mitigation of sentence :--

Lieut. G. Payett. Royal ERe Regiment.

I have known Pte. Vachon for several months, he is a keen, good working and honest soldier. It is true that he took liberty to use some money belonging to the canteen, but he did not steal that money, he berrowed it, I say borrowed it, because he tried to repay by giving two payments back, which I am sure went to prove his intention was not to keep that money.

If he was negligent in doing his duty, I am positive that the authority in charge of that Company Canteen was negligent as much as he was.

For this reason, I ask the clemency of the Court for Pte. Vachon.
