had not been advised of the exact date from which appoint-
ment was to be effective. Your 12-11-2 of February 7
requested that you be advised of the date duties commenced.
I am particularly glad that pay is effective February 1st
as these teachers were grounded at Terrace for 14 days
after leaving here. The plane tried to get into Aiyansh,
ran into ice and had to make a very speedy exit to Terrace.
