Re yours of March 8, 1949, file 12-11-2, the reason why Miss Freeman's salary was requested to commence at February 18, 1949 was that this was the date she left for Aiyansh by plane; at which date this office had not been advised of the exact date from which appointment was to be effective. Your 12-11-2 of February 7 requested that you be advised of the date duties commenced. I am particularly glad that pay is effective February 1st as these teachers were grounded at Terrace for 14 days after leaving here. The plane tried to get into Aiyansh, ran into ice and had to make a very speedy exit to Terrace.
