- Well if the Indians were restricted to the Reserve land, for feeding their cattle, would they have enough food for them'.
- A. Yes.
- Q. Bid they have any more eattle before this shooting took place?
- A. I comnot cay.
- Q. What do you may as to there being sufficient pasturage on this seserve for the eattle which you think the adiams would keep if they had enough encouragement to do ec.
- A. Wall between the Crown Lands and the Reserve Millede I think there would be enough pasturage.
- THE CHAIRMAF: That number of eartle shall be kept on this reserve in the power table portures they have here on this poerve and on the power table.
- A. I should judge they would be easily able to keep the number they have now.
- Q. Do I understand you to say that they could keep only 29 cattle and 15 horses on this Reserve
- A. Tes. Shey could mave their eattle on to other Reserves, but on this one Reserve should judge they could easily raise from 50 to 40 head of eattle.
- Q. Well them that gives them the privilege of disposing of their estile as they like.
- A. Yes.
- DR.MOKRHEA: If all the adjoining Open Lands were taken up by presuptors about how many head of eattle could they keep on this
- A. I should judge about 30 09 40 head of cattle.
- THE CHAIRMANT. I suppose this adjacent pasturage has good timber on it. Is it good land .
- A. You good footing land?.
- Q. Well if that timber was out off, it would be quite good pasture land
- A. Yen.
- MR. Young: Oun you give us the population of the bank here ?.
- A. 354 according to the last statistics, wit a possible addition of
- Q. Gould you give us the heads of families, that is all the males ever 10 and all widow wenes, and all groups of orphans.
- A. She Departmental Statistics are all that I could give. There a book in the office giving the ages of all the different Indians.
- Q. What has been the tendency during the last five years to increase or to decrease.
- A. With this bank it has been about equal. The allow number of births and deaths.
- Q. That is your observation, that they have about held their own ?.
- A. Yes.

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
