POSTOFFICE MONEY ORDERS. Payable in Canada, Newfoundland and the United States.

(The limit for a single order is \$100.) On orders up to \$5, 3c; over \$5 and up to \$10, 6c; over \$10, and up to \$30, 10c; over \$30 and up to \$50, 15c; over \$50 and up to \$75, 25c; over \$75 and up to \$100, 30c.

Payable in the United Kingdom, British Possessions (except Newfoundland), and all distant countries upon which Money Orders—may be obtained. (The limit for a single order on these countries is \$50). On orders up to \$10, 10c; over \$10 and up to \$20, 20c; over \$20 and up to \$36 30c; over \$30 and up to \$40, 40c; over \$40 and up to \$50, 50c.

Postal Notes are payable only in Canada and United States and are bought and paid at any Money Order and Postal Note Office. On note for 20c, 1c; 25c, 1c; 30c, 1c; 40c, 1c; 50c, 2c; 60c, 2c; 70c, 2c; 75c, 2c; 80c, 2c; 90c, 2c; \$1, 2c; \$1.50, 2c; \$2.00, 2c; \$2.50, \$2; \$3, 3c; \$4, 3c; \$5, 3c. Odd cents may be made up by affixing Canadian postage stamps not exceeding 9c in value to the face of a Postal Note.
