3.—The vaults must annually during the month Cleansing of of July, be fumigated, cleansed, aired and made ready for receiving, on and after the First of November of each year.

XXIII. All bodies of persons dying of infectious Infectious diseases must, if the grave has not been prepared in advance, be placed in the infectious diseases vault, and interred within twenty-four hours, unless, the ground is in an unsuitable condition for burials, in which event, then at the earliest possible date.

1.—Removals from the Cemetery of the bodies of persons who died of any infectious disease will not be permitted, except with the written permission of the Board of Health.

2.—The following will be considered as infectious diseases:—Small pox, asiatic cholera, diphtheria, typhus fever, scarlet fever, scarlatina, and such others as may hereafter be designated by the Trustees, or the Board of Health.

XXIV. The bodies of deceased persons who have Cremation. expressed a desire, either in their wills or codicils, that their bodies be cremated, may be cremated in accordance with the Charter of the Company and the following regulations:—

- 1. Before cremation of a body can take place, Statutory the Trustees must be furnished with the statutory declaration referred to in Section 31 of the Charter.
- 2. Cremation, as well as the disposal and delivery Cremation of the ashes, shall take place under the direction of of Supt. the Superintendent of the Company.
- 3. The coffins in which the bodies are burned coffins to be of shall be constructed entirely of wood and joined without the use of metal nails or clasps or metal
