BE it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the County of Northumberland, shall, and may have power, and they are hereby authorifed and empowered, to Julices at a Special Sef- hold a Special Seffion of the Peace in and for the faid County, at the Court House of the same County, at any time within the month of March, in the prefent year, for the purpose of appointing Commisfioners and Surveyors of Highways, and other Officers for the feveral Towns or Parishes within the faid County; which Town or Parish Officers to appointed shall be duly fworn, and be liable to ferve in their feveral and respective stations, and shall have the same power and authority to all intents and purpofes, and be fubject to the like pains and penalties for refuling to lerve, as if the same Officers had been appointed under and by virtue of an Act made and paffed in the Twenty-fixth Year of the Reign of his prefent Majesty, intituled, " An Act " for the appointment of Town or Parish Officers in the several Coun-"ties in this Province," or by any other Act now in force, authorifing the appointment of any Town or Parish Officers; and shall hold and exercise their respective offices until others shall be legally
