Mr. Chipman moved for leave to withdraw the bill "to en-" able the proprietors of a Peninfula of interval land lying at " the entrance of the river Oromocto to erect a temporary gate " and fence acrofs the road laid out there," and to substitute in " the room thereof " A bill to authorife the erection of tem-" porary gates across certain roads in the feveral counties in this " province where the fame shall be found necessary and for other " purpoles therein mentioned."
