If you are not contented with the amount of money you are making perhaps this will console you some: "Wages in Great Britain average much higher than on the continent, and in France and Germany wages are higher than in Italy, Spain or Austria. The district court at Carlsbad, Austria, recently fixed the daily wages of laborers of both sexes for the years 1907, 1908 and 1909, as follows: Males, foremen, 60 cents per day, others 40 cents, and apprentices and boys, 20 cents. Females, 28 cents, and uveniles, 18 cents. Servants of the state, 48 cents, except servants of the post and telegraph, who receive 44 cents.
