with a good-sized courtyard surrounding it, the outer walls of which are decorated with hideous, ill-executed frescoes of the various punishments in the Buddhist Hell, differing very little in character from those one so often sees depicted in Roman Catholic

churches in Italy. The deepest and hottest hell, with the most gruesome fiends to poke the fire, is reserved for those who rob a Buddhist priest or plunder a Buddhist temple. The great relic, which is two inches long and one inch thick, is preserved in a gold and jewelled shrine, covered by a large silver hell in the centre of an octagonal tower with pointed roof.
