What is the Society in Eagland doing?
It is organizing and rousing the National Church to do battle with the National sin.
It has more than 1,000 branches spread throughont every Diocese in England and Walea, besides many in India and the Colonies.
These are affording a scope for the energies of Lay-workers in carrying the Gospel to poor drunkards, of both sexes, formerly regarded as hopelers outcasts.
Prevention, as well as care, is carefully ca!tivated, and the young, in bandreds of thousands, are being trained as Abstainers and Soldiers in the Crusade.
With the valued aid of many who are not Total Abstainers, counter attractions, such as Coffee-houses, cocoa and reading rooms, clubs, concerts, lectures, instructivo en tertainments, peuņ-bänks; \&c. \&c., are competing with much succers, with the public-house and gin palace.
Publio Opinion is being power fully influenced.
Social customs rapidly modified.
Many hundreds of Tomperance sermons are preached overy year, and more than 1,000 meelings, held every week by the various branches.
Publications. - The "C.E.T. Chronicle (1d weekly): The Young Standard Bearer, for children ( $\frac{1}{2} \mathrm{~d}$ monthly).

One and a third millions of tracts leaflets, stories, cards, and cther publications are distributed yearly by the depot at Westminster:
The official staff of the Society (inoluding the officors of affliated brancher) consiste of :
Superintendent (Hon. Clerical), Assistant Secretary and carhier.
25 Diocesan Orgranizin! Secreta ries (of whom 17 are clerical), actively spreading the work into fresh patishes, with the help or sanotion of the clergy, and sup. port the great army of voluntary workers.
12 Misaionaries [one of them a lads], attending Pulieo Courts filled ohictly by tha criminal intemperate.
5 Female Missionaries emploged by branches of the Women's Union and two collectors.
6 Officers of the seven Central departments, viz.

1. Publication depot, manager.
2. Leginlativedepart., worked by superintendent.
3. Women's Union, lady secretary.
4. Javenile Union, lady secretary.
B. Agricultural depart. worked by assistant seoretary.
5. Army division, organizing agent.
6. Cabmen and 'busmen's division, agent.
Each department (with one ex. ception) is directed by a special sub.committee, appointed $b_{y}$ the central executive.
