

6. a) Subject to sub-paragraph (b) of this paragraph, this Agreement shall initially remain in force until July 1, 1977; thereafter the Agreement shall remain in force for an indefinite period unless either Government denounces this Agreement by giving six-months' notice in writing of such intention.
b) In the event that either Government considers that an emergency situation exists such as war, invasion, insurrection or riot, real or apprehended, either Government may suspend this Agreement.
7. In case of denunciation or suspension of this Agreement pursuant to paragraph 6 above, the Governments of the Kingdom of the Netherlands and Canada shall consult regarding appropriate arrangements for the phasing out of any training programme under way in Canada at the time of such denunciation or suspension.

If the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, I have the honour to propose that this Note, which is authentic in English and French, and your affirmative reply, shall constitute an Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands which shall provisionally be applied as from the date of your affirmative reply and shall enter into force effective from September 1, 1971, on the date on which our two Governments have notified each other in writing that they have obtained whatever internal approval each may require to give effect to this Agreement.
