

9. October 28 - Washington - Preparatory Conference of the World Food Board. The Canadian Delegation, headed by Dr. H. Barton, Deputy Minister of Agriculture, included Dr. J.F. Booth and Dr. C.F. Wilson of the Department of Trade and Commerce; Mr. Mitchell Sharp, Department of Finance, and Mr. G.R. Paterson of the Canadian Embassy in Washington.
10. October 28 - Dublin - International Commission of Aerial Navigation. Mr. E.J. Garland, Acting Canadian High Commissioner in Ireland, attended on behalf of Canada.
11. October - Rio de Janeiro - Second Pan-American Congress of Mining, Engineering and Geology. Mr. V.L. Hardley Wilmot, Department of Mines and Resources, was the Canadian representative.
