RESOLUTION 40.

A Resolution for the relief of Christina Fearn Lawson Nortranders.

[Adopted 23rd February, 1966.]

WHEREAS Christina Fearn Lawson Nortranders, residing at the city of St. Lambert, in the province of Quebec, wife of Svend Valdemar Nortranders, otherwise known as Svend Valdemar North, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the city of Montreal, in the said province, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the twenty-second day of October, A.D. 1955, at the city of Ottawa, in the province of Ontario, she then being Christina Fearn Lawson; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore the Senate of Canada, pursuant to the provisions of the DIS-SOLUTION AND ANNULMENT OF MARRIAGES ACT and subject to section 2 thereof, resolves as follows:—

1. On the expiration of thirty days from the date of the adoption by the Senate of this resolution, the said marriage shall be dissolved and thenceforth shall be null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.
