BUSINESS OF THE HOUSE

Mr. Pinard: Mr. Speaker, I see it is quarter to ten or nearly so and there is a vote scheduled for tonight. Rather than start the debate on the next bill now that there is barely a minute left, I suggest to my colleagues that they agree to call it quarter to ten.

I would like to use this opportunity, Mr. Speaker, to say immediately out of courtesy for my colleagues that tomorrow we will be considering Bill C-18 first, to be followed immediately by Bill C-31. I have good reasons to believe after consultation through some of my colleagues that Bill C-18 should not require too much time tomorrow afternoon and we will once and for all be able to proceed with Bill C-31 which will allow the Secretary of State for External Affairs (Mr. MacGuigan) who has been here since yesterday as well as the hon. member for Kingston and the Islands (Miss MacDonald) to make their speeches tomorrow afternoon, and I do hope so.

So the order of business of the House for tomorrow, Mr. Speaker, is Bill C-18, followed by Bill C-31. If tomorrow morning certain bills come back from committees—I am thinking in particular of Bill S-2 and Bill C-13—we would like to call one of those bills as a third item for discussion tomorrow afternoon. I see it is a quarter to ten, Mr. Speaker. I ask that you call it a quarter to ten.
