Mr. Cameron (Victoria, Ont.) then moved in amendment thereto, that the Bill be re-committed to a Committee of the Whole to amend the same by providing that sub-section 6 of section 46 be expunged, and the following substituted therefor:—6. The votes of the electors shall be taken by ballot in the manner provided by "The Canada Temperance Act, 1878," and the several *Clauses* thereof under the headings "The Poll"—"Scrutiny"—"Penalties"—"Preservation of the Peace"—"General Provisions"—"Prevention of corrupt Practices"—and "Penalties and punishments generally" shall be read and construed as part of this Act, except where inconsistent with any of the provisions herein contained;—which was agreed to.
