Under existing conditions, with no one wile and willing to take a full-time position, we have been obliged to employ a our number of teachers on a part-time basis. This number has, moreover, been all the larger because of the increasing conviction that men should be aptitle presentance taught in small groups at the bedside (6-8). The classes have been large (180 in the present final year), thus necessitating the present unusually large staff. With, however, the adoption, a few years ago of a default. limitation of students in the first year to 100, we are now at a stage where next year our final class will be reduced to less than 100, and so it will continue.
