mission money, entrance fee, or other pecuniary benefit; who has never competed with, or against a professional of any class for a prize; never engaged in athletics in any way as a means of livelihood; who has never been employed in any occupation involving the use of the oar or paddle, who receives no pecuniary benefit from his rowing connection, and whose membership of any rowing or athletic club was not brought about, or does not continue, because of any mutual agreement or understanding expressed or implied, whereby his becoming or continuing a member of such club would be of any pecuniary benefit to him whatever, direct or indirect.

ARTICLE IV.

MEMBERSHIP.

SECTION I. The representative body of this Association shall be composed of two delegates from each Club, in alternates, assembled in an Annual Convention, or if necessary at more frequent periods.

SEC. 2. Any Club desiring to join this Association shall make written application to the Secretary of this Association enclosing a membership fee of \$15 (to be returned if
