GUIDE ON THE GROUND OF EXHI-BITION.

Department of Agriculture.

Visitors before entering will provide themselves with a ticket which they may buy at the office, at the entrance of St. Augustin street.

The main entrance for visitors is on the Grande Allée (St. Louis road).

In order to see every thing, visitors will have to commence first by looking round the Agricultural Department. On turning to the left will be found the different breeds of horses, from the Canadian pony to . the blood stallion.

After the horses, will be seen bulls, cows, pigs, &c.

After having seen the several species of cattle, visitors should step, in the second building to examine seeds and vegetables, as well as poultry, pigeons, birds, &c.

After leaving this place, visitors will step in the main building by way of St. Augustin street, where will be exhibited articles of Art and Industry.

The Department of Industry.

In the first walk will be exhibited carriage and other wood works, &c., on the second walk will be found sewing machines, machinery and other iron works, on the third walk the jewellery, printing, book-binding, &c., and on the fourth and last walk will be exhibited cabinet makers' and other wood works.
