Obviously what the president has inmind is that there shall be restored that old Balkan League which won the first Balkan war and broke down under Austrian intrigue before the second. Could Greece, Bulgaria and Serbia settle their differences as to Macedonia (and a settlement might have been had under the guidance of Venizelos if Austria had permitted it in 1913), then the Balkans would cease to be the fighting ground of the great powers, and with Rumania these three states might make a compact Balkan alliance, which would insure mutual freedom against all comers. But this would be still another wall thrust between the Austro-German mass and the Turkish lands in which Germany hoped and hopes to find her colonial place in the sun.
