PAULIST CHORISTERS
COME NEXT THURSDAY

Much interest is being manifested in the appearance here on Thursday evening, January 17, of the celebrated Paulist Chorists of Chicago, reputed to be possibly the finest church choir in America. They are coming to London under the direction of the Musical Art Society.

In 1912 this choir visited Paris and participated in the International Musical Congress, at which was gathered the finest choir of Europe and America, and where examples of the world's greatest choral music were presented. The performances of the Paulist Chorists on this occasion were awarded the much-coveted first prize diploma.

The choir is making a six months' concert tour of the larger cities of Canada and the United States, under the auspices of the French restoration committee, and have assumed the heavy burden of raising \$100,000 to augment the exchequer of the commission to aid in the rehabilitation of ruined French and Belgian cities. The tour has the approval of President Wilson.

The coming of this famous organization ranks in importance with the visit of the noted Sheffield choir to London a few years since. Tickets are on sale at the music stores, and the plan opens at McIntosh's on Monday next.

COUNTY DELEGATION TO MEET HIGHWAYS HEAD AT TORONTO

To Discuss Revised County Road System.

BYLAW ALREADY PASSED

City Has Not Acted as Required by the Highways Act.

On Wednesday afternoon, January 18th, a deputation from the county council will meet in conference at the Parliament Buildings, Toronto, with Deputy Minister of Highways W. A. McLean and other public highway representatives.

The conference is arranged to discuss the authorization by the highways department of the establishment of a revised county road system for Middlesex.

At the December session a bylaw with respect to such a revision was passed but nothing will be done until the bylaw receives the sanction of the highways department officials.

The object in view was the establishment of an inter-provincial highway system under which the county receives a grant much larger than that at present allowed.

To make the system complete the city was asked to co-operate by inaugurating a suburban road area.

Commissioners were to have been appointed by the city council to confer with the county council deputation, and the joint committee was then to deputation to the minister of highways.

The city council commissioners were never appointed and as far as the city is concerned nothing has been done.

In a letter to Engineer Talbot that under the Ontario highways act the city is obliged to appoint commissioners.
