**NOT CONTENDER
FOR NOMINATION,
STATES M'ADOO**

Wilson's Son-in-Law Decides
That Expenses Are Too
Great.

NEW YORK, June 18.—William G. McAdoo, son-in-law of President Wilson, who has been considered by party leaders as one of the principal candidates for the Democratic presidential nomination, announced tonight he could not permit his name to go before the San Francisco convention.

"This decision," he said, "is irrevocable, as the path of duty seems to me clear and unmistakable."

His decision was made known in a telegram to J. M. McKim, Democratic delegate-at-large from Kansas, who had telegraphed Mr. McAdoo that sentiment throughout the United States was rapidly crystallizing in his favor.

He declared he must have a reasonable opportunity to rehabilitate his family, and having been out of office less than eighteen months, he has not been able to accomplish this.

A presidential campaign, Mr. McAdoo explained, imposes upon the candidate unavoidable expenses, which, he said, he was unable to assume, and which he did not want his friends to assume.

Mr. McAdoo was formerly a member of the Wilson cabinet.

**LITTLE GIRL BRUTALLY
BEATEN BY MASKED MAN**

Was Playing With Small Brother—
Assaultant Made His Escape.

GUELPH, June 18.—An outrageous assault was committed on little Evelyn Thompson, six-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. George Thompson, 24 Hudson street, last night, when a strange man wearing a mask gave the child a severe lashing with a whip.

The outrage took place on the bank of the Speed River, at a point near the Dominion Casket Company plant, where the little girl and her older brother were playing just about dusk. The man rushed the little one until she fell to the ground. As her brother, who is ten years of age, was the only eyewitness of the affair, he looked on helplessly, and before he could notify any person about the assault the man had made a getaway.

The police made a thorough search of the district shortly after the affair occurred, but could find no trace of the stranger.

The child was taken to her home, and a physician summoned. On examination, it was found that she was badly bruised about the body, but it is believed that her condition is not serious.

**LABOR CHOSES
COMPERS WITH
ENTIRE CABINET**

Federation Elects Veteran
President For Thirty-
Ninth Time.

PLEDGES OF SUPPORT

Rail Workers Say Govt.
Ownership Resolution Not
Repudiation.

MONTREAL, June 18.—The American Federation of Labor again expressed its confidence in the leadership of Samuel Compers, its veteran president, here today in its 40th annual convention, when it re-elected him for the 39th time and returned to office his entire administrative cabinet.

His election was practically unanimous, as the only delegate that voted against him was James A. Duncan of the Seattle Central Labor Council, leader of the Progressive wing of the federation.

The delegates gave the aged labor leader a tremendous ovation as he again assumed the leadership, declaring that he would accept the challenge and "I will obey." He was much affected by the demonstration of applause and cheers which continued for several moments.

Not Closed To Progress.

After asserting that his "mind is not closed to progress, but would continue to attempt to lead the army of workers to victory," President Compers denied a story syndicated by a news service to the effect that he "had suffered his first defeat in the executive council, when he had failed to get the council to ask the Republican and Democratic parties to declare for light wine and beer."

The entire executive council which is President Compers' cabinet, was re-elected.

The convention tonight elected Timothy Healy of New York president of the stationary firemen, and Sara B. Conboy of the textile workers, fraternal delegates to the British Trades Union Congress. The convention then adjourned until tomorrow.

The support of the organized railroad workers in the federation was pledged to President Compers by Charles J. MacGowan, who seconded his nomination. He said the convention's action in endorsing government ownership of railways should not be construed as a repudiation of the labor leader's administration.

Other officers were re-elected as follows: James Duncan of Quincy, Mass., first vice-president; Joseph P. Valentini of Cincinnati, Ohio, second vice-president; Frank Duffy of Indianapolis, Indiana, third vice-president; William Green of Coshocton, Ohio, fourth vice-president; J. Tobin of Boston was re-elected treasurer, and Frank Morrison of Washington secretary without opposition.

W. D. Mahon, Detroit, Mich., fifth vice-president, and T. A. Rickert, Chicago, sixth vice-president, were unanimously re-elected.

W. H. Johnston, international president of the railroad workers' organizations, opposed Jacob Fischer of Indianapolis for election as seventh vice-president, but was defeated by a vote of 18,195 to 17,329.

Matthew Wolf of Chicago was unanimously elected eighth vice-president.

Charge of Murder.

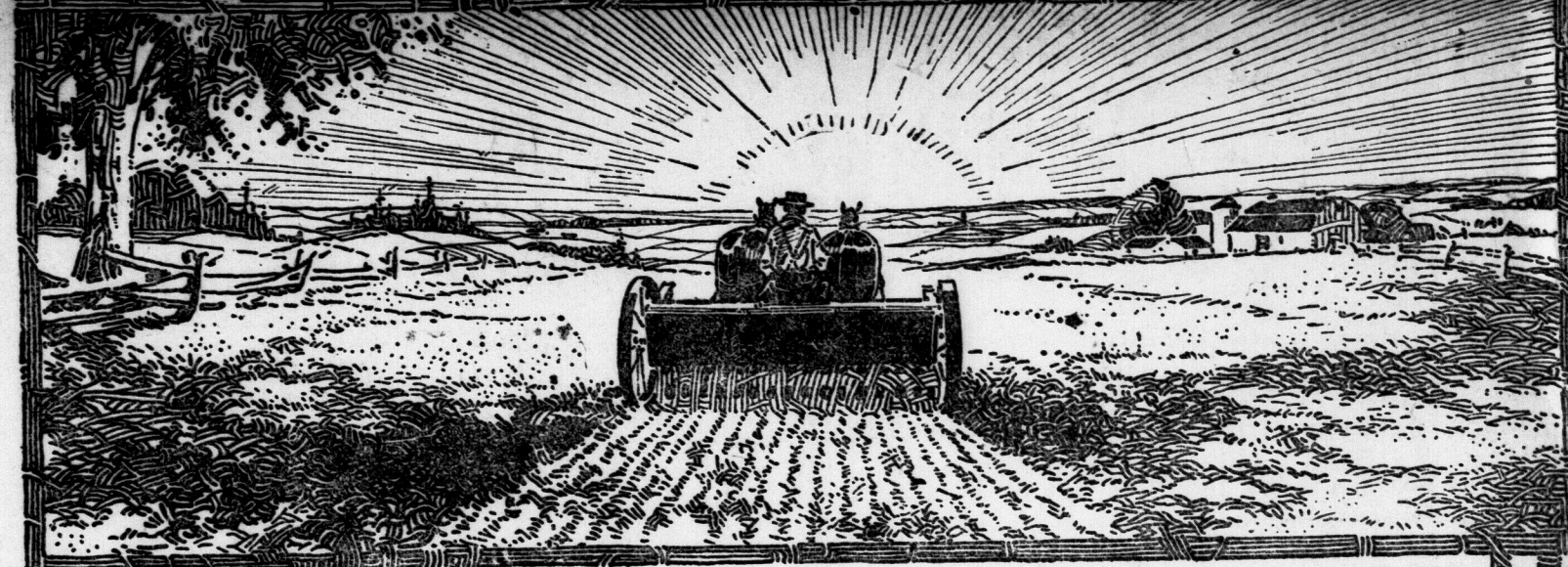
Charlottetown, P. E. I., June 18.—The defence in the Ellis case was begun yesterday. Ellis is charged with murdering his wife on January 6. Counsel for Ellis, addressing the jury yesterday, argued that Mrs. Ellis, who was a nurse and met her husband as a soldier in an English hospital, was homesick and frequently flew into rages. She disliked farm life and wanted to leave.

The first witness for the defence was Evelyn Ellis, sister of the prisoner. She told of an attack on her brother by his wife and swore that on the day of her death he was not near his wife's room all day, until 6 o'clock, when he finished work at the hospital. Deceased stayed in her room all day. Witness heard her moving around. After prisoner had come in, in the evening, and went to his wife's room, he called to witness, who was in the cellar, and said that his wife had cut her throat.

**PATROLMAN SAVES
CAR AND DRIVER**

SARNIA, June 18.—The speedy action of Patrolman Frank Eason at the local end of the late afternoon is all that saved a man whose name is withheld by the police pending further action, losing his life in the St. Clair River. The man is alleged to have been in an intoxicated condition, and was driving his auto over the ferry dock when Patrolman Eason jumped on the runningboard and grabbing the wheel, steered the car into the safety fence.

U. S. GOVT. EXPENDITURES.
Washington, June 18.—Governmental expenditures from July 1, 1919, to May 31, 1920, amounted to \$20,775,335,558, according to a statement last night of the United States treasury. Expenditures were heaviest during September, when \$4,475,937,701, was spent, and lightest in November, when \$11,301,764 left the treasury.

THE chemist has shown the chief elements promoting plant growth to be nitrogen, acid phosphate and potash.

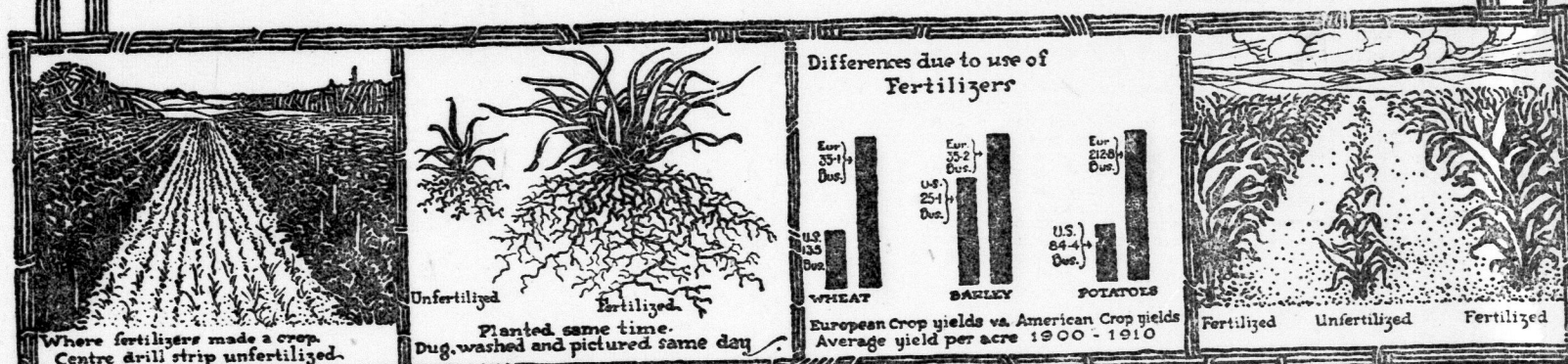
It is estimated that just now there is a world shortage of 15,000,000 tons of acid phosphate.

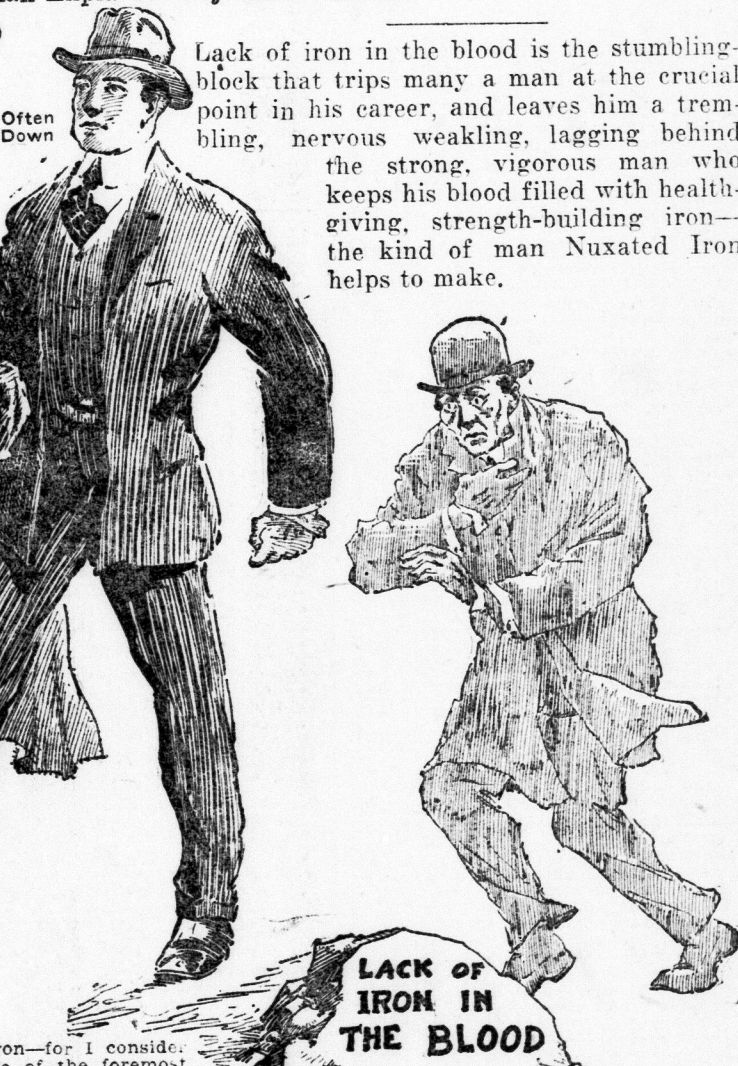
