Also the best mode of conducting the Home during the two months' holiday allowed by the Indian Department was discussed, and on the motion of the Rev. G. Holmes and Mr. G. Harvey it was agreed to open a subscription list for the maintenance of the children at the Home during the holidays.

The Bishop then declared the Acts of the Synod, and closed with the benediction (7.30 p.m.).
