a bunch of keys. He had discovered that there was left of Mr. Jones' watch and, pending his arrival, the bones were covered with planking. Previous to the fire the watch had been in the pocket of the coat and they were busy hunting for some time among the bones of one whom they had known. Upon the coroner's arrival the watch and other effects were carefully placed in a small box and carried away. An inquest will be held this evening. That Mr. Jones entered the paint shop when it was almost in flames is the belief of many. He had in the building a small compartment where he kept several caddies of tobacco which he retained to the moment the door of this place he kept locked. It is further understood that he had money in the room.

A theory is that he rushed into the shop, made his way to the room which was about fifty feet from the spot where his remains were found, and that in attempting to return perished. His deplorable death has aroused general sympathy, for he was practically a life-long resident of the county and enjoyed the good will of all. His wife, Mrs. M. Jones, is prostrated and her and her daughters the deepest sympathy has been extended. never I have ever seen. Within ten minutes after I saw it first the whole of the paint shed was completely enveloped in flames. It was a very difficult conflagration to fight. THE I. C. R. AND SUBURBANITES

Something About the New Suburban Rates Which Will Be Effective After March 1.

The transcript understands that new passenger rates which will go into effect on the Intercolonial railway on March 1st are as follows: From 200 to 400 miles, 2.50 cents per mile; from 401 to 600 miles, 2.40 cents per mile; from 601 to 800 miles, 2.30 cents per mile; from 801 to 1,000 miles, 2.20 cents per mile. For commercial travellers the rate will be 2.14 cents instead of 2 cents, as now, and the 1,000 mile ticket is also advanced from 2 cents to 2.14 cents per mile. Season tickets are abolished and the following substituted: Ten ride tickets at 2 cents per mile; 50 ride tickets at 1.12 cents per mile. It is impossible to estimate what this increase of rates means in increased revenue. There is little doubt, however, that although the rate is not advanced for strictly local business, on distances above 100 miles will be appreciable from a revenue standpoint. The rates are still lower than those in the Grand Trunk and Canadian Pacific in many respects. (Daily Sun.)
